BACHELOR OF EDUCATION – PROGRAMME

The Quality of teacher education depends on the quality and relevance of the innovations adopted in imparting it. Successful conduct of teacher education programme depends upon the factors such as availability of the infrastructural facilities, competence, and commitment of the faculty, work climate, instructional ethics and leadership management style.

DURATION OF THE B.ED PROGRAMME

The B.Ed Programme shall be for duration of two academic years consisting of 200 working days - 36 hours in a week - 5 or 6 days in a week each year, excluding the period of examination and admission.

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

The students in I year B.Ed. programme are limited to only 100. So every year we have only **200 students** in the college

STAFF: As per the University norms sixteen teaching staff and five non-teaching staff are appointed in the college.

OPTIONALS OFFERED IN THE COLLEGE:

Tamil, English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Biological Science, History, Commerce and Computer Science

INFRASTRUCTURE:

The College has well furnished library, science lab, Psychology lab, language lab, Computer lab, Seminar hall and Media Hall. The staff and students make well use of them for better learning.

YOUTH PASTORAL AND ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

DAILY, WEEKLY AND MONTHLY ACTIVITIES are carried out with utmost care and responsibility by the staff and students. Daily Good morning talk during the morning assembly is given by the sisters, staff and students too in order to motivate our life with sound values needed for a teacher.

Thrice a week an hour of Catechism and Value education classes are conducted to live in Christian faith and acquire good values for better life. The students and staff have annual retreats so as to renew their relationship with God and to gain spiritual strength.

MICRO TEACHING PRACTICE:

Quality of a teacher is estimated on how much the students understand from his/her teaching. Therefore the student teachers are trained in various teaching skills. Two weeks of special coaching is done in the microteaching skills. The following are the skills:

- Introduction Skill
- Skill of Probing Questions
- Skill of Explanation
- Skill of Stimulus Variation
- Skill of non verbal cues
- Skill of Reinforcement
- Skill of fluency in communication
- Skill of Black-board Writing
- Skill of Achieving Closure

TEACHING PRACTICE

The Student Teachers are sent to the nearby schools for training of Macro teaching practice for four months in the second year of the course. The programme is intended to bridge theory and practice by providing opportunity for practical learning. Consequently, participants are given the opportunity to demonstrate clear understanding of the best practice in different teaching methods to meet students' learning needs and classroom management skills.

CLUBS: The students can join in any of the following clubs to be in a group for various associated activities to develop their talents and leadership skills and to reach out to the society in social service. The clubs are:

SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS:

Orientation Programmes for staff and students are organized at the beginning of the academic year so as to insert oneself into the academic programme. Staff have monthly animation on Preventive System in order to acquire the spirit of Don Bosco in their teaching career.

Seminars on Life coping skills, Health and Hygiene, Preventive System, Innovative methods in teaching, Class room management, Human Rights education, awareness Programmes on social and Environmental Issues, Leadership training, Scout Masters and Guide Captain training and Relaxation techniques are conducted during the year.

National, Cultural and Religious festivals are celebrated in a grand manner to teach the students the significance of it and to share the happiness with one another. Visit to Innovative Schools & Outings
